Directive 2011/65/EU of the European Parliament and the Council on the Restriction of the use of certain Hazardous Substances (RoHS).

Atlantex Manufacturing Corporation (AMC) understands that products manufactured by this company may be sold within the European Union (EU). Because of this, an initiative has been taken by AMC to identify the use of hazardous materials in our products. AMC can confirm RoHS and REACh compliance for the following list of product lines:

- Pyrotex Products- (PT Industrial & Aerospace grade, PT-HLC, SA, SG Tape, Rope, Blanket)
 - o RIO, Black, Blue, Red, Green, Aluminized finishes
- Pyrotherm Products (HS, HT, HW, LW, FR, FGT)
- Tufftex Abrasion Products (TF, TF-HLC, TFB)
- Tadpole Tape Products (Fiberglass, S/S, Inconel, Silicone varieties)
- KevTex Products (KS)
- Spiral Guard Wrap (SGW)

RoHS Compliance

Atlantex Manufacturing Corporation certifies that all of our products designated as RoHS Compliant conform to the requirements of EC Directive 2011/65/EU (RoHS). Directive 2011/65/EU of the European Parliament and of the Council of June 8, 2011 became effective in January 2013. As a result, some provisions of Directive 2002/95/EC will be eliminated and new provisions of Directive 2011/65/EU will be introduced. Atlantex Manufacturing will continue to monitor the status of these Directives in order to meet any additional requirements. Compliance of Atlantex Manufacturing Corporation is maintained through strict control of our supply chain and input materials.

Atlantex does not intentionally manufacture the above products with the following substances restricted by EU Directive 2011/65/EU with concentrations above the Maximum Threshold Limit of 100 ppm (0.01% by weight):

- Cadmium and its compounds
- Mercury and its compounds
- Hexavalent chromium and its compounds
- Lead and its compounds
- Polybrominated biphenyls (PBB)
- Polybrominated diphenyl ethers (PBDE)
- Decabromine diphenyl ether (DECA BDE)

REACh Classification/ Substances of Concern

EC 1907/2006, released in June 2007, specifies duties and obligations regarding the Registration, Evaluation, Authorization, and Restriction of Chemicals (REACh) for companies in the European Union that manufacture or import substances either on their own, in preparations, or in articles. Per the structure of the REACh Regulation, AMC is a manufacturer and supplier of "articles," as we do not manufacture or supply "substances" or "preparations," and our articles do not involve the "intentional release of substances." As such, AMC does not anticipate any registration or pre-registration requirements for the articles we manufacture and supply. To the best of our knowledge, articles supplied by AMC do not contain Substances of Very High Concern (SVHC) as defined by REACh, and AMC does not specifically analyze for the presence of these substances.
